Day 1

New York - Princeton - Philadelphia - Lancaster - Washington D.C. (240 miles)

Princeton University (optional, 45mins) →Independence Park, Liberty Bell, Independence Hall (exterior, 15mins) →Philadelphia Double Decker (Mandatory, 50mins) →Amish Village (optional, 90mins)

> Princeton University

Founded in 1746 as the College of New Jersey. Guests will explore the campus, led by a student tour guide to learn more about academics, as well as the college culture.

> Independence National Historical Park

A United States National Park in Philadelphia that preserves several sites associated with the American Revolution and the nation's founding history. Philadelphia's most-visited historic district. The park has been nicknamed "America's most historic square mile".

➤ Liberty Bell

It has been nicknamed "Independence Bell". The Liberty Bell is an iconic symbol of American independence and freedom.

> Independence Hall

Independence Hall is the building where both the United States Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution were debated and adopted. The building is listed as a World Heritage Site.

Philadelphia Double Decker

Starting from the stock exchange building, will be revisited along the way: the first White House, the first congress hall, the first library, etc... The bus will stop at the Love Square a world-class landmark. The journey takes about 13 miles and passes through the birthplace of more than 30 East American historical cradles in Philadelphia. You will hear the rich history and culture of Philadelphia.

> Amish Village

Despite the development of the contemporary technologies in the 21st century, the Amish still live a rural way of life.

Day 2

Washington D.C - New York (250 miles)

The bus tour will first depart hotel straight to D.C and first stop will be the 【US Capitol】. A Walking In-depth tour inside of the Capitol, accompanied by a professional US CONGRESS Tour Guide, who is going to show us inside the Capitol, as well as the Rotunda and the Crypt. Following next will be the 【White House】 (Exterior), the principal residence and workplace of the U.S. President. Visit one of the most famous landmarks in the world, the 【Lincoln Memorial】 along with 【Korean War Memorial】 and 【Vietnam Memorial】. After Lincoln Memorial we will take 【Capital Cruise】 which rests on top of the Potomac River, the national river of the United States, with the exclusive view of The Pentagon, the Department of Defense. If time allows, we will we will additionally visit 【Madame Tussauds Presidents Wax Museum】.

• If U.S Capitol is unavailable, the 【Washington D.C In-depth Tour】 will be replaced to 【Marine Corps War Memorial】, 【US Air Force Monument】 which is the only place where you can look up at the Pentagon 911 Monument.

➤ United States Capitol

Library Of Congress

The Library of Congress (LOC) is the research library that officially serves the United States Congress and is the de facto national library of the United States. It is the oldest federal cultural institution in the United States.

> Supreme Court of the United States

It is the highest court in the federal judiciary of the United States.

> The White House

The White House is the official residence and workplace of the President of the United States.

Lincoln Memorial

It was set up to commemorate the US President Lincoln. The beautifully decorated wall engraved with the famous speech from this outstanding person. Martin Luther King published his most famous speech here, "I have a dream." Many films such as "Forrest Gump" .

> Vietnam Memorial

It honors service members of the U.S. armed forces who fought died and MIA in the Vietnam War.

> Korean Memorial

Its Wall of Remembrance and 19 stainless steel statues commemorate the sacrifices of the millions of Americans and allied partners who fought during the Korean War.

Washington D.C Cruise

Which rests on top of the Potomac River, the national river of the United States, with the exclusive view of The Pentagon, the Department of Defense.

> President Museum

It is designed in accordance with the structure of the White House and can be taken with photos of the Presidents and other celebrities such as Lincoln, Clinton, Obama and Trump.
