**Summer (June-October):**

Cave of Wind (Optional, 90mins) → Illumination of Niagara Falls (Optional, 60mins)

**Winter (November-May):**

Corning Glass Museum (Optional, 120mins) → Illumination of Niagara Falls (optional, 60mins)

➤ **Niagara Falls**

Among the most beautiful natural wonders in the world, Niagara Falls are comprised of three waterfalls that thunder and astound, producing a higher flow rate than any other waterfall in the world and standing at a height of 167 feet.

➤ **Cave of Wind**

The Cave of Winds on the New York side of Niagara Falls is an attraction which allows people to walk along pathways on the river at the base of the Bridal Veil Fall.

➤ **Illumination of Niagara Falls**

Hundreds of LED lights are housed in three locations across the Niagara Gorge in Niagara Falls, Ontario. Together, these lights work to create a breathtaking view not to be missed, and are illuminated every night of the year beginning at dusk.

➤ **Corning Glass Museum**

The Corning Museum of Glass is home to the world's most comprehensive collection of glass, the world's foremost library on glass, and one of the top glass working schools in the world.

**Day 2****Niagara Falls - Washington D.C. (410 miles)**

Hotel: Comfort Inn / Day Inn / Red Roof Plus or similar

Departure from hotel to **【Niagara In-Depth Tour】** by visiting the Whirlpool Park first, a short and relaxing stroll along the Niagara Gorge. Afterwards, continue our way to Niagara Fort located at the mouth of the Niagara River flowing into Lake Ontario. You will have the opportunity to experience the power of nature by enjoying a breathtaking **【Jet Boat】** ride through the fastest moving water in the world. Following, we will visit the heart pounding **【Maid of the Mist】**, the world-famous boat ride that will take you right into the heart of the Niagara Falls

**Winter** (November-May):

- Jet Boat: For safety reasons, children must be over 4 years old to join.
- Jet Boat will be adjusted according to the specific weather conditions (in case of snowstorms, ice on the Niagara River and various bad weather conditions will be suspended).

➤ **Niagara In-depth Tour**

An in-depth tour of this famous and historic area takes passengers through some of the lesser-known stories that surround Niagara Falls. We will visit Old Fort Niagara and Whirlpool State Park.

➤ **Jet Boat**

Jet Boat is the must-do thrilling whitewater and historic river boating experience. Enjoy a breathtaking guided tour through the spectacular Niagara River Gorge and the famous Whirlpool while our experienced Captains safely navigate the treacherous world-class rapids.

➤ **Maid of Mist**

This famous boat ride is perhaps Niagara Falls' most popular attraction. Get ready to get wet: the Maid of the Mist takes its passengers as close to the falls themselves as it is possible for anyone to get.

➤ **Niagara IMAX Legend Movie**

Legend Movie takes you on a heart-pounding ride over Niagara Falls. Travel back in time to learn of its 12,000-year history and experience the death defying stunts performed by daredevils who challenged the fury of Niagara Falls.

**Day 3**    **Washington D.C – New York** (240 miles)

The first stop will be the **【US Capitol】**. A Walking In-depth tour inside of the Capitol, accompanied by a professional US CONGRESS Tour Guide, who is going to show us inside the Capitol, as well as the Rotunda and the Crypt. Following next will be the **【White House】** (Exterior), the principal residence and workplace of the U.S. President. Visit one of the most famous landmarks in the world, the **【Lincoln Memorial】** along with **【Korean War Memorial】** and **【Vietnam Memorial】**. After Lincoln Memorial we will take **【Capital Cruise】** with the exclusive view of The Pentagon, the Department of Defense. Then we will visit Philadelphia, the birth place of the United States. Spend time at the **【Independence National Historical Park】** to see the **【Independence Hall】** and the **【Liberty Bell】**. We will take **【Philadelphia Double Decker】** to see the whole view at City of brotherly love Philadelphia.

Covers: U.S Capitol (Indoor, 75mins) 、 U.S Library (Indoor, 15mins) 、 Supreme Court (Exterior, 10mins) →The White House (Exterior, 20mins) → Lincoln Memorial, Korean War Memorial, Vietnam Memorial (45min) →Capital Cruise (Optional, 50mins) →Philadelphia Double Decker (Optional, 50mins)

**Pass By:** Jefferson Memorial, Washington Monument, World War II...

**Remark:**

- If U.S Capitol is unavailable, the **【Washington D.C In-depth Tour】** will be replaced to **【Marine Corps War Memorial】**, **【US Air Force Monument】** which is the only place where you can look up at the Pentagon 911 Monument.
- **United States Capitol**  
The United States Congress is the bicameral legislature of the Federal government of the United States. The legislature consists of two chambers: the House of Representatives and the Senate.
- **Library Of Congress**  
The Library of Congress (LOC) is the research library that officially serves the United States Congress and is the de facto national library of the United States. It is the oldest federal cultural institution in the United States.
- **Supreme Court of the United States**  
It is the highest court in the federal judiciary of the United States..
- **The White House**  
The White House is the official residence and workplace of the President of the United States.

- **Lincoln Memorial**  
It was set up to commemorate the US President Lincoln. The beautifully decorated wall engraved with the famous speech from this outstanding person. Martin Luther King published his most famous speech here, "I have a dream." Many films such as "Forrest Gump" .
- **Vietnam Memorial**  
It honors service members of the U.S. armed forces who fought died and MIA in the Vietnam War.
- **Korean Memorial**  
Its Wall of Remembrance and 19 stainless steel statues commemorate the sacrifices of the millions of Americans and allied partners who fought during the Korean War.
- **Washington D.C Cruise**  
Which rests on top of the Potomac River, the national river of the United States, with the exclusive view of The Pentagon, the Department of Defense.
- **Independence National Historical Park**  
A United States National Park in Philadelphia that preserves several sites associated with the American Revolution and the nation's founding history. Philadelphia's most-visited historic district. The park has been nicknamed "America's most historic square mile".
- **Liberty Bell**  
It has been nicknamed "Independence Bell". The Liberty Bell is an iconic symbol of American independence and freedom.
- **Independence Hall**  
Independence Hall is the building where both the United States Declaration of Independence and the United States Constitution were debated and adopted. The building is listed as a World Heritage Site..
- **Philadelphia Double Decker**  
Starting from the stock exchange building, will be revisited along the way: the first White House, the first congress hall, the first library, etc... The bus will stop at the Love Square a world-class landmark. The journey takes about 13 miles and passes through the birthplace of more than 30 East American historical cradles in Philadelphia. You will hear the rich history and culture of Philadelphia.
