➤ **Great Smoky Mountains National Park**

A Wondrous Diversity of Life, World renowned for its diversity of plant and animal life, the beauty of its ancient mountains, and the quality of its remnants of Southern Appalachian mountain culture, this is America's most visited national park.

➤ **Titanic Museum**

Victors seem to be in a scene 100 years ago. At the center of the museum is a replica of the "Titanic" staircase, worth \$1 million.

➤ **Dolly Parton's Dixie Stampede**

The dinner show features friendly North and South competition, jaw-dropping horse-riding stunts, extravagant special effects, lively musical productions and a four-course feast that's sure to please any palate.

Day 3**Chattanooga - Virginia (400 miles)**Hotel: Quality Inn/ Red Roof Plus or similar

Today is all about the natural beauty of**【Lookout Mountain】** in **Chattanooga**. **【Ruby Falls】** being the first stop of the day, is a underground waterfall which welcomes thousands of visitors each year, it has been one of the best Chattanooga attractions for over 85 years. The next stop will be the **【Incline Railway】** which is billed as one of the world's steepest passenger railways. Tour will then stop at **【Rock City Garden】** . Take an unforgettable journey along the Enchanted Trail where each step reveals natural beauty and wonders along the woodland path. Our last attraction today will be **【Knoxville Zoo】** .

Itinerary :

Ruby Falls (Optional, 60mins) →Rock City Garden (Optional, 60mins) →Incline Railway (Optional, 30mins) →Knoxville Zoo (Optional, 60mins)

➤ **Ruby Falls**

The Ruby Falls is located inside the ruby cave of Tennessee. The cave is filled with stalactites, stalagmites, flowing stones, etc. And a waterfall can be seen from the sky under the colorful lighting.

➤ **Incline Railway**

The railway is approximately one mile in length, and has a maximum grade of 72.7%. It obtained Historic Mechanical Engineering Landmark status in 1991.

➤ **Rock City Garden**

It is a true marvel of nature featuring massive ancient rock formations, gardens with over 400 native plant species, and breathtaking "See 7 States" panoramic views.

➤ **Knoxville Zoo**

It's the No.1 Red Panda conservation in the World, and one of the premiere zoological experiences in the southeast. There are more than 800 animals in the zoo and attracted more than 400,000 visitors every year.

Day 4 Virginia - New York (500 miles)

This morning tour will bring us to **【Natural Bridge】**, it has been designated a Virginia Historic Landmark and a National Historic Landmark. Then After lunch we will return to New York.
