D1.New Orleans(MSY)Airport Pick Up/Night Tour

As guests arrive at the airport in new orleans, they should meet their tour guide by the luggage carousel and transfer to the hotel.

- A. Free group pick-up: 9: 00 AM-9: 00PM, required at the airport waiting for another flight passengers.
- B. 24 hours private shuttle service: \$ 80 / (1st & 2nd guest), \$ 10 /each additional guest.

D2. Oak Alley Plantation-Swamp Tour

In the early morning we will visit the **Oak Alley Plantation**, They are the view finder of movie *Gond with the Wind* and *Interview with the Vampire*. 28 Oak trees in Oak Alley Plantation are over 300 years old and also known as 'treasure of plantation.' We will also go on a **swamp tour** in the Bayou, Get up close and personal with the bayou! These tours take guests into protected swamps to see some of the South's unique indigenous wildlife. Afterwards, we will have the chance to go to go to a crocodile viewing area.

D3. New Orleans City Tour
