D1: Home-Seattle airport pick up- morning and evening tour

Morning tour: Flight arrivals before 15:00PM, Microsoft Headquarters & Amazon Spheres (adult: \$ 35 / person; children: \$ 25 / person);

Night tour: Flight arrivals before 17:00PM, Fisherman's wharf & Starbucks original baked coffee experience museum (adult: \$ 25 / person; children: \$ 15 / person);

Package tour: morning & night tours, adults: \$ 50 / person; children: \$ 30 / person.

Seattle Airport Pick-up mode A, B, C:

A. Free shuttle services: 9: 00AM - 10:00 PM, waits for other guests, heading to hotel as soon as the shuttle is full. \$ 10/guest/day gratuity will be collected by tour guide at your last tour day.

B. 24 hours private shuttle service: \$ 120 / (1st & 2nd guest), \$ 10 /each additional guest.

D2: Seattle-Spokane-Missoula

[Spokane] is Washington's second largest city and also the northwest inland area of the central city. Riverside Park and Spokane Falls are the city's most famous attractions, while Riverside Park is also the 1974 World Exposition venue.

[50, 00 Silver Dollar shop] is Montana's largest gift shop. It was originally opened in 1951 on the 10th highway shop; the customer is mainly near the lumberjack. D3: Missoula - Yellowstone National Park

[Yellowstone National Park] is the first national park in the United States, but also the world's first national park. Yellowstone Park is known for its rich wildlife species and geothermal resources. The largest lake in the park is the Yellowstone Lake in the center of the Yellowstone volcano, which is one of the largest high-altitude lakes in North America.

[Roosevelt Arch] a rusticated triumphal arch at the north entrance to Yellowstone National Park. Constructed under the supervision of the US Army at Fort Yellowstone, its cornerstone was laid down by President Theodore Roosevelt in 1903. The top of the arch is inscribed with a quote from the Organic Act of 1872, the legislation which created Yellowstone, which reads: "For the Benefit and Enjoyment of the People".

[Mammoth Hot Springs] Many algae live in Mammoth Hot Springs, making the color of the hot spring, orange, red and green. The endless hot springs with the terrestrial Pentium down, and the color is different, forming a colorful big step, the scene is very magnificent spectacular.

[Yellowstone Grand Canyon & Yellowstone, under the waterfall] Here is the Yellowstone Park, one of the most magnificent, the most beautiful scenery. Here, the rapids of the river spray splash, forming two magnificent waterfalls, are roaring with the bottom of the people. The first waterfall is 33 meters high, which is on the waterfall, the second has 92 meters high, called the waterfall. At the same time, we will go to the Yellowstone Grand Canyon Best View (Artist Point) to see the magnificent Yellowstone Canyon. In the afternoon, we drove back to Missoula.

We will continue to explore the Yellowstone Park by visiting Mammoth Hot Springs, Grand Canyon, Upper & Lower Yellowstone Falls and etc.

D4: Yellowstone National Park- Missoula

Yellowstone Park is also the core of the Great Yellowstone ecosystem, which is the largest and still near-perfect natural ecosystem in the northern temperate zone.

[Old Faithful] Yellowstone's most famous geyser, it is not like other fountains that broke out without law, it every few minutes, it will erupt once, never make the passengers disappointed. It is always one of the faithful by the world's favorite.

[West Thumb Geyser Basin] Fifty thousand years ago due to the formation of the collapse of the crust, in the hot fountain and lake water, there has been a smoke filled the wonderful landscape, here is equivalent to Yellowstone Lake, many geysers gathered here, formed with other hot springs Yellowstone Different landscape.

[The Grand Prismatic Spring] is also known as the Rainbow Hot Springs, is the largest in the United States, the world's third largest hot spring and one of the most famous geysers in Yellowstone Park. The

beauty of the big prism spa is the color of the lake changes with the seasons, the spring, the lake from green to bright orange red.

Around no, we will arrive in the Yellowstone. You will discover the most popular styles including Old Faithful, West Thumb Geyser Basin, The Grand Prismatic Spring and many more.
