D1: Seattle-Spokane-Missoula

[Spokane] is Washington's second largest city and also the northwest inland area of the central city. Riverside Park and Spokane Falls are the city's most famous attractions, while Riverside Park is also the 1974 World Exposition venue.

D2: Missoula - Yellowstone National Park

[Yellowstone National Park] is the first national park in the United States, but also the world's first national park. Yellowstone Park is known for its rich wildlife species and geothermal resources. The largest lake in the park is the Yellowstone Lake in the center of the Yellowstone volcano, which is one of the largest high-altitude lakes in North America.

[Roosevelt Arch] a rusticated triumphal arch at the north entrance to Yellowstone National Park. Constructed under the supervision of the US Army at Fort Yellowstone, its cornerstone was laid down by President Theodore Roosevelt in 1903. The top of the arch is inscribed with a quote from the Organic Act of 1872, the legislation which created Yellowstone, which reads: "For the Benefit and Enjoyment of the People".

[Mammoth Hot Springs] Many algae live in Mammoth Hot Springs, making the color of the hot spring, orange, red and green. The endless hot springs with the terrestrial Pentium down, and the color is different, forming a colorful big step, the scene is very magnificent spectacular.

[Yellowstone Grand Canyon & Yellowstone, under the waterfall] Here is the Yellowstone Park, one of the most magnificent, the most beautiful scenery. Here, the rapids of the river spray splash, forming two magnificent waterfalls, roaring with the bottom of the people. The first waterfall is 33 meters high, which is on the waterfall, the second has 92 meters high, called the waterfall. At the same time, we will go to the Yellowstone Grand Canyon Best View (Artist Point) to see the magnificent Yellowstone Canyon. In the afternoon, we drove back to Missoula.

D3: Grand Teton National Park & Yellowstone National Park

We will head to Grand Teton National Park. Grand Teton, at 13,775 feet (4,199 m), is the highest point of the Teton Range, and the second highest peak in the U.S. state of Wyoming after Gannett Peak. The mountain is entirely within the Snake River drainage basin, which it feeds by several local creeks and glaciers. Rising above a scene rich with extraordinary wildlife, pristine lakes, and alpine terrain, the Teton Range stands monument to the people who fought to protect it. These are mountains of the imagination. Mountains that led to the creation of Grand Teton National Park where you can explore over two hundred miles of trails float the Snake River or enjoy the serenity of this remarkable place.

[West Thumb Geyser Basin] Fifty thousand years ago due to the formation of the collapse of the crust, in the hot fountain and lake water, there has been a smoke filled the wonderful landscape, here is equivalent to Yellowstone Lake, many geysers gathered here, formed with other hot springs Yellowstone Different landscape.

D4: Yellowstone National Park- Missoula

The Yellowstone volcano is the largest volcano in North America that is still active, and it has erupted several times over the past two million years. [The Grand Prismatic Spring] is also known as the Rainbow Hot Springs, is the largest in the United States, the world's third largest hot spring and one of the most famous geysers in Yellowstone Park. The beauty of the big prism spa is the color of the lake changes with the seasons, the spring, the lake from green to bright orange red.
